



 - More reliable, lower cost, smaller footprint, better ambience.




Timeline

- Oct 2014 budget approved
- Nov Jan 2015 site visits
- March 2015 'mock up'







































Timeline



- Jul 2015 final design, tender issued
- Sep 2015 contractor selection
- Jan 2016 public launch, fundraising
- Apr Jun 2016 installation
- Feb Jun 2016 Visitor Welcome project
- Jun 2016 commissioning
- Nov 2016 Bishop Nick dedication



Financials



- Cost £134k, met by
 - £86k from HLF
 - £24k surplus from earlier project
 - Remainder from other grants and individuals
- Cost savings?
 - £20 30 pcm at most

Benefits




- Aesthetic






Lessons and conclusions
