How does the PGS

work?

The PGS is a safe and secure way of giving regularly to [Church Name]. Regular giving can be giving monthly, quarterly or annually.

Giving on a monthly basis follows this

- The donation goes to the PGS team on the 1st of the month
- The PGS team receive the donation and claim any eligible Gift Aid on the 3rd/4th of the month
- The initial donation is credited to the church account by the 10th of the
- The additional Gift Aid is credited to the church account by the end of the month.

Giving monthly, on the first day of the month, helps us offer our first fruits to God

 - People smiling






