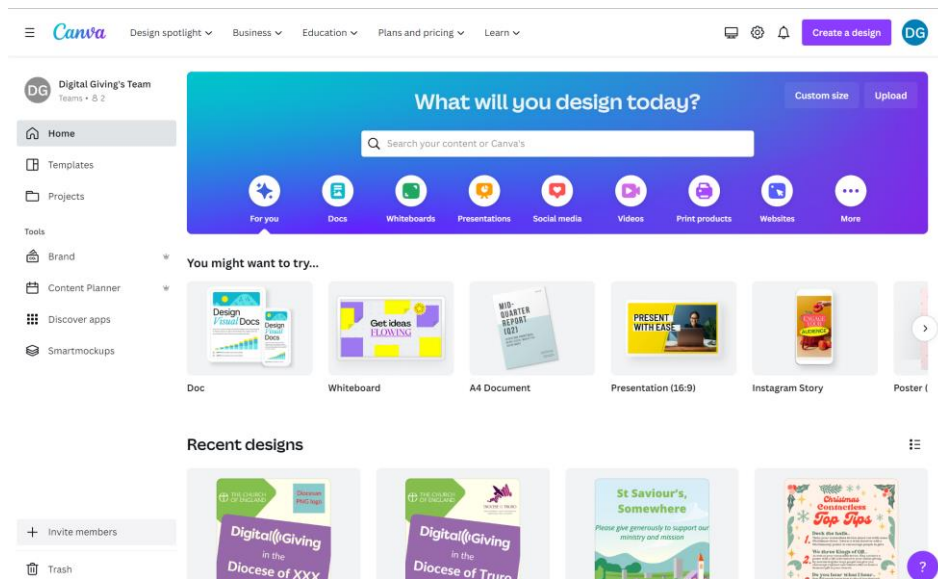


Canva onboarding

- User-friendly **graphic design tool** for creating posters, resources, logos, newsletters and social media content.
- It can be used to create **PDF, JPG, PNG, MP4** and **SVG** files.
- The design and editing aspect of Canva is similar to Publisher and PowerPoint
 - functions for text, font, image uploads, and a range of free stock photos and graphics with the Pro version.

Canva Pro

- More templates
- Better range of stock images
- **Edit suite: background remover**
- **Brand: set up a brand colour palette, logo, fonts etc.**

Registering for Canva

Free version:

For the simple free version, follow this link: https://www.canva.com/en_gb/

And enter your work email address, set up a password, and verify your account from your email.

Premium version:

£99.99 per year **OR** free as a non-profit

Registering for Canva Pro for free

You will need:

Your work email, proof of charity status (ACNY certificate, Diocesan Charity Number)*, address, mission of the church/Diocese.

* Charity Registration Number from Charity Commission, CIC Registration Number from CIC Regulator, Articles and Memorandum of Association

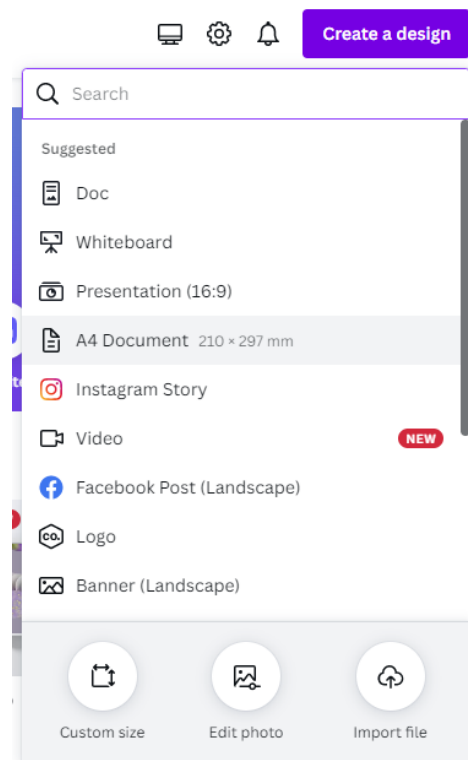
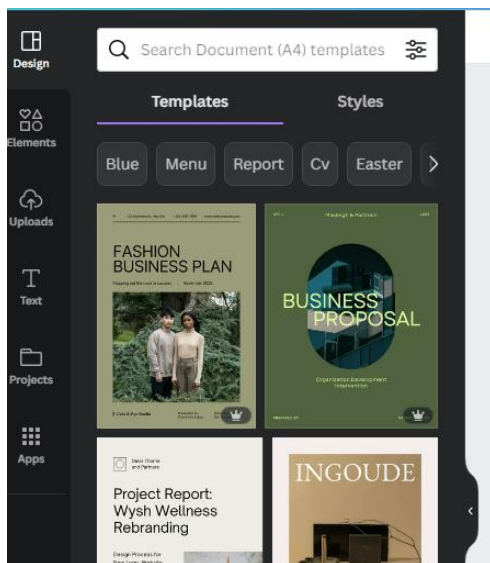
How to get started

Click **“Create a design”**

Choose what size you would like.

e.g. A4 Document

You can either **select a template to edit**:



Or use the **tools on the left hand column** to design one yourself.

Those tools include: **Elements** (e.g. photos and graphics), **Uploads** (your own images), **text** (text boxes with a variety of fonts) and **projects** (where you can set up your brand colour, logo, font etc.)

How to download your document

Once you have completed the document, you can download it as a range of files, the most common are PDF or PNG/JPG images.

In the top right corner click **Share** > **Download** > *choose your file type* > **Download**
