

PARISH GIVING SCHEME -BENEFITS




- Free regular planned giving service designed to make giving easier and more efficient for parishes
- Give by Direct Debit
- Set up gift online, over the phone or by post
- Gift Aid claimed by PGS team
- Option for donor to increase giving annually by rate of inflation
- Increased levels of giving seen. Average Weekly Gift at £17.94 in August 2024.


PGS – BENEFITS TO THE TREASURER

2 Weekly donors:


104 transactions a year

PGS – GASDS CONSIDERATIONS

To be able to make a GASDS Claim on

£4,000 of:

- Sunday collections
- Baptism collections
- Wedding collections
- Funeral collections
- Donations boxes
- Wall safes
- Contactless donations

You would need to receive a *minimum* of

£400

in donations from individuals via:

- Standing Orders
- Numbered Giving Envelopes
- One-Off (Aggregated) Giving Envelopes
- Bank transfers or cheques



TREASURER AMBASSADOR UPDATE

- Easy Ambassador Registration: Form on Linktree & in post-meeting email
- One Role Name: Feedback has been that having 2 names is confusing

Clear Role Description: Details on next slide

TREASURER AMBASSADOR ROLE

Treasurer Ambassadors:

- Strengthen the treasurer network
- Support fellow treasurers online & in person
- Review Diocesan materials before publication
- Give feedback on desired training & events
- Mentor new treasurers
- Collaborate with Diocesan staff

Q&AS



Q1. How long does the Parish Giving Scheme hold on to your donations before placing in your church bank account?

A. All donations come out of the donor's bank accounts on the 1st of the month and reach the PGS bank account on 3rd or 4th of month. The PGS then prepares any gift aid claims and submits to HMRC and transfers the donations to reach your banks account by the 10th month. The gift aid will reach your bank account later the same month depending on how long HMRC take to process the gift aid claim. On some occasions the GA might not arrive until early the next month. In the majority of cases though treasurers have reported that the gift aid comes in the same month. The PGS have an interest barring bank account which prevents them from making any interest on the donations they hold in their account. There were a lot of positive comments about the PGS made by treasurers on the Form meeting.

Q2. Is there any specific advice when moving church bank accounts online?

A. It's a good idea to move to online banking for a number of reasons. Barclays Bank were suggested as being very good for offering an easy to use dual signatory process where churches have a dual mandate set up. Virgin Bank also use it but do charge fees though.

Q3. Would it be possible to have a Treasurer WhatsApp group in the Diocese which would make it easier for treasurers to contact each other with questions?

A. This has now been discussed with the Diocesan senior leadership team and we have the go ahead to set this up early in the new year. Volunteer treasurers would be needed to help with the moderation of the group. Please indicate this on the google form that has been emailed with this presentation.

Q4. Would it be possible to ask Parish Buying if they could negotiate with bank to secure free banking for parishes?

A. A request for this has been sent to Parish Buying and will update at the next Treasurer Forum meeting. Some treasurers have said that free banking is available through Nat West and Virgin banks if you have a charity number.

Q5. Do all churches have to register with the Charity Commission?

A. At the moment PCCs have to register with the charity commission as soon as their church's annual income surpasses £100,000. However, by end of March 2031 all PCCs with an annual income over £5,000 will need to be registered with the Charity Commission.
